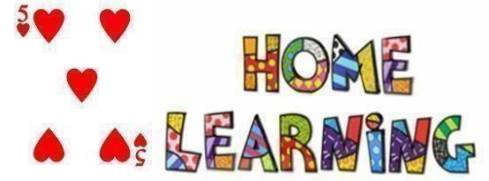


Year 5 Home Learning
